DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

MESSAGE OVERVIEW

It's easy to lose hope for something better, especially when you're not seeing any signs of hope. This was the case for Ezekiel. He was a priest in exile in Babylon. But God gave him a vision for something better, something in the future. It was a sign of hope for Ezekiel that God wasn't done with Israel. It was a sign of hope that there was more. It's also a reminder for us that there is more... more power.

READ EZEKIEL 37:1-14

Is there anything you know God can do if you ask, but feel like He won't? If there is more of God's power available to us, in what ways would it compel us to live differently?

Whose resurrection could God be calling you to help participate in? Who could you speak life into?

What would it look like to see the intersection of God's Word and God's Spirit among us at UCC? How would things be different?
