Have you ever been part of a church that desired something more than Jesus alone? What about one that settled for less than the fullness of Jesus?

Paul says here that unity is achievable for the church. Where does that unity come from? What does the church have to commit to in order to be unified?

What is God saying to you through this passage of Scripture?
In light of this, how are you going to be different in the future?
