MESSAGE OVERVIEW

One of our biggest problems as human beings is our addiction to ourselves. We're selfish. If we drift, it's going to be toward selfishness, NOT selflessness. We have to discipline ourselves to put others' needs and desires above our own. To become like Jesus, we have to serve.

READ LUKE 22:24-27

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

How does minimizing our own desires magnify God?

Consider this statement: "Humility isn't thinking less of yourself, it's thinking of yourself less." Why is this important when talking about serving others?

When you hear the phrase "church member," do you picture a person who is served, or a person who serves?

Why is it important for our own personal and communal transformation to serve others?
